#### SIX simple steps:

Get your box

- 1. Decide who you would like to help. You can choose a boy, a girl, a woman, a man, a baby, a cat, a dog or a box for small animals (or you can do them all)
- 2. Fill your box with items listed below
- 3. For an extra lovely touch write a small note of support for the person receiving the box
- 4. Seal your box
- 5. Print off your box description label or write on the box who it is intended for
- 6. Lastly weigh your box and write the weight on the label or on the box

There are no limits to the number of boxes you can create. If you wish to supply a pet box please fill with none perishable goods.

Please bring your completed boxes into Dartmouth Yacht Club at the start of the week commencing 28th March where they will be collected ready to be distributed in the next week or so.

This is just a simple and small way we can all help and I know you will all want to get behind this and make a difference.

## **Ideas for box contents**

#### Child - Girl

- scarf, woolly hat, gloves
- crayons, pencils, paper, colouring books
- toothpaste, toothbrush, facecloth, soap, body wash
- a game or a puzzle
- Small towel/face cloth
- non-perishable snacks

#### **Male Adult**

- scarf, woolly hat, gloves
- toothpaste, toothbrush, facecloth, soap, body wash, deodorant
- New socks, new underwear
- Small towel/face cloth
- non-perishable snacks

#### **Child – Boy**

- scarf, woolly hat, gloves
- crayons, pencils, paper, colouring books
- toothpaste, toothbrush, facecloth, soap, body wash.
- a game or a puzzle
- non-perishable snacks
- Small towel/face cloth

#### **Female Adult**

- scarf, woolly hat, gloves
- toothpaste, toothbrush, facecloth, soap,
- body wash, deodorant
- Female sanitary products
- Small towel/face cloth
- New socks, New underwear
- Non-perishable snacks

#### Baby

- Nappies, wet wipes, cotton wool
- blanket, baby formula, disposable bottles
- small towel
