Did you know ? DYC is a thriving club of 1600 members. In addition to a great staff team, it is run entirely by a committee of volunteers, assisted by additional small groups of volunteers. All generously give their time to enable the club to function for all to enjoy.

However, we have a problem..... A number of committee members have resigned over the summer, leaving responsibility for running the club to even fewer people. Additionally, many of the current committee have been in post for a number of years and may not be looking to continue next year.

We therefore have an immediate need to fill three vacancies (with the possibility of more vacancies to come in January 2023 when we next hold the AGM and re-elect the club officers and general committee).

The three vacant roles we urgently need to fill are:

Club Treasurer: This post will ideally suit someone with the necessary finance skills and experience who is able to come in as soon as possible as our existing treasurer is not standing for re-election next time and the handover will take a little time. As September 30th is our financial year end this is a great time to get involved and see how it all works.

Honorary Club Secretary: This role primarily involves organising the committee meetings and AGM, as well as attending to general club enquiries with the assistance of other committee members.

Maintenance Manager/Coordinator: Our lovely club house is an old building with an endless to do list of items to repair, maintain and improve. Some of this work is undertaken in house using volunteers, however much is carried out by contractors who require organising and monitoring on behalf of the club.

What's in it for me ? Well, there's certainly no financial benefit to getting involved(!) however volunteering can be very rewarding in other ways:
