By signing below I confirm that I understand ALL the following:

- I have sole responsibility for the safety of the vessel and all aboard and understand I may be personally liable in event of any personal injuries caused during my use of the boat.
- Buoyancy aids / life jackets must be worn by all onboard AT ALL TIMES
- A kill cord must be worn by the driver at all times.
- The boat must not be taken to sea outside the Harbour Limits
- No more than 6 people can be aboard at any one time, this includes children.
- I am responsible for complying with all Harbour Authority requirements and the International Rules for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea (IRPS).
- Boaters may be prosecuted under the Merchant Shipping Act 1995 if their actions on the water are seen to be endangering other vessels, structures or individuals, and they are under the influence of alcohol.
- I must top up the fuel at the end of my trip via the DYC account on the fuel barge and report the reason if I have not been able to do so.
- I am responsible for the collection of the keys and boat safety equipment cannister, paddles, boat hook etc which MUST be carried on the boat. This equipment can be collected from the storage location (see below) and must be returned at the end of the session.
- I am responsible for replacing any parts of the boat lost or damaged, including the key and must notify the club immediately if any damage or loss occurs.
- No claim can be made against the Dartmouth Yacht Club in regard to the boat's use or users.
- The boat must be left clean and tidy and locked with the securing wire and padlock if fitted.

NB Doris's equipment is located in the cage at the back of the Club. The Bar Staff will issue the boat key. Doris is usually berthed outside the club on the DHNA Yacht Club Pontoon during the season.

Sarah's equipment is located in the wooden storage box in Coronation Park. The key to padlock will be provided by the bar staff. Sarah's boat keys are inside the safety equipment cannister. Sarah is usually located on the DHNA Low Water Pontoon DB39.

Failure to comply with any of the above may result in permission to use the motor boats being withdrawn
